Your days in school are:

Times of the school day:

Drop off time: **9:20 – 9:30am**

Collection time: **2:40pm – 2:50pm**

All Year 6 children **must be accompanied by an adult to school on a morning**. Parents/carers must wait at main pedestrian gate. Children will be escorted into school through the gate by members of staff socially distanced. Parents will not be able to enter the site. Your child will be brought back to the main gate at the collection time. Year 6 pupil **are allowed to walk home alone at the end of the school day** if parental consent is given via the school office in advance.

Your bubble will be in: CLASSROOM 11



- Children will remain in the same bubble throughout the day including lunch times and break times.
- Children will have their lunches at desks in their classrooms.
- Children will not be required to wear school uniform but should wear appropriate clothing for outdoor and indoor learning. Clean clothes should be worn each day.
- Our outdoor area will be Zone 6 (Bottom Field Area).
- Things you should bring to school are: packed lunch, water bottle, coat and a hat and sun cream. All other items should be left at home.

What we will be learning:

Whilst in school, we will be focusing on various transition activities to prepare the children for their move to secondary school. Our home learning program will continue on the other days of the week which will continue to focus on the core curriculum areas i.e. Maths, English and Science. Please see the weekly home learning timetable for Year 6 which can be found on the school website as usual.

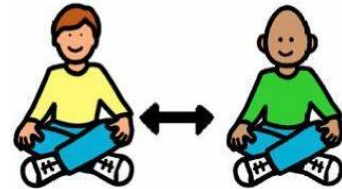
When you come back to school..
