Maths

The following skills are taught this term:

- Counting forwards and backwards from 0-20
- Reading and writing the numbers 0-20
- Simple addition and subtraction (within 10)
- Identifying 2d and 3d shapes



One of the most beneficial ways to help your child understand mathematical concepts is for them to work practically and in real life situations. You can help your child develop their maths skills by counting with them at home. Being confident in counting will help your child in all areas of Numeracy.

PE

This term our PE day is **TUESDAY**. Children are asked to wear PE kit on PE days to reduce the need for PE bags and changing in school. This can remain on all day. In colder months, children will be able to wear track suit bottoms and hooded PE tops.



This term our topic will be Movement skills. During these topics your child will develop fundamental movement skills including running, jumping, throwing and catching. We will participate in many different activities that will allow your child to become confident in these areas.

RE

This term in RE we will be learning about the different features of a church. Children will be able to label the features from both inside and outside of a church.
