Dear Parents & Carers,

The weeks leading up to Christmas are normally some of our busiest and most enjoyable. It is apparent with the latest news from Government, that Christmas this year will not be what we are used to, however, we are determined to ensure the children receive the best possible experience at school, to put them in the festive mood!

We have already started to make plans to ensure that children get to take part in some festive events at school.

With new government restrictions in place until 2^{nd} December, it is inevitable that further restrictions will remain in place if we want to spend time with our loved ones over Christmas.

We are also aware of the rising number of cases of COVID-19 in the local community. To keep everyone safe in our school community, we must all do our bit to keep everyone safe.

<u>Please can we strongly advise that ALL parents and carers wear a mask when on school grounds. The One-Way system is effective, but social distancing isn't always possible. When wearing masks, parents and carers are helping to keep all adults safe.</u>

For the foreseeable future, we must insist that ONLY ONE ADULT TO collect their child/children from school, unless there are exceptional circumstances, which have been discussed with Mrs Woods or Miss Webb.

We have signed up to an online reading scheme called myOn. This links to our Accelerated Reader programme which already runs in school from Year 2 to Year 6 (Classes 5 to 14). Over the next week your child will come home with log in details. They will be set reading books to read linked to their reading age. On top of this they will have access to over 5,000 books to read in their free time. Children who are in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 (Classes 1 to 6) will continue to bring an actual school reading book home. These books match directly to the

Coats and Wellies

The winter weather is very unpredictable and **ALL** children must come to school in warm winter coats. Getting outdoors is very important, and our school grounds can get quite muddy. Can you please ensure that children have a pair of wellies in school at all times. Wellies can come to school in a carrier bag with your child's name on. If children need to wear their wellies to walk to school, e.g. due to snowy weather, they must bring some indoor shoes to change into. Thank you for your support.

REMINDER - Is my child too ill for school?

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school, when they're unwell.

There are government guidelines for schools that say when children should be kept off and when they shouldn't. If you do keep your child at home, it's important to phone the school on the first day of your child's absence to let us know that they won't be in, and the reason for their absence. We do have an answer machine for out of office hours, so please feel free to leave a message as necessary.
