School Uniform

Please can we remind all parents and carers that children must wear their school uniform to school every day unless they are having PE. On days when children have PE, they can come to school in their PE kit.

Our School Uniform:

- Navy blue, grey or black trousers
- Pale blue polo shirt or blouse
- Navy blue jumper/cardigan
- Suitable shoes (not sandals, Ugg style boots or crocs)
- Blue checked dresses and grey shorts are suitable for the summer

Please do not send your children to school in hoodies, or other or unsuitable clothing or footwear. Thank you.

Jewellery Policy - Watches

Watches are not allowed in school; this includes any type of SMART watch or fitness band.

If a pupil is found in possession of a smart watch, then the following procedures apply:

- On the first occasion the smart watch will be confiscated, and the pupil may collect the watch from their class teacher at the end of the school day.
- On the second occasion a member of staff will contact parents via a phone call, text, email or letter. Parents will be requested to collect the smart watch at the end of the school day.
- In the event of a pupil refusing to hand over a smart watch when requested to do so, we will contact parents immediately.
