### Lateness

School starts between 8.35 and 8.55am (Staggered times due to the pandemic). Your child will receive a late mark if they arrive after 9.00am. If your child arrives after 9.15am, they will receive an unauthorised absence mark (U Code) which will affect their overall attendance percentage.















#### Uniform

Please can we remind parents that children <u>must</u> attend school wearing full school uniform every day, unless they have PE lessons. Children should come into school wearing their PE kits on the days they are timetabled for a PE lesson.

#### Our school uniform consists of:

- Navy blue or grey skirt or trousers
- Pale blue polo shirt or blouse
- Navy blue jumper or cardigan (not a hooded top!)
- Suitable sturdy shoes (not sandals, Ugg style boots, Crocs or laces)
- Suitable hairstyles no shaved patterns in hair and long hair must be tied back from the face with a bobble
- Blue checked dresses and grey shorts are suitable for the summer

#### Children should not be wearing hooded tops/PE hoodies as jumpers in school.
