ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

The Department for Education advise that high quality face-to-face education remains a government priority. Children should attend school every day unless they are unwell. Parents must contact our school office on the first morning of their child's absence to report the reason for non-attendance.

All children must arrive by 8.55am each day. Our school gates will close promptly at 9am.

Being punctual for school means making sure your child is at school and ready to learn by 8.55am. Being late doesn't only affect your child, it disrupts other children in the class as well as the teachers trying to teach a lesson.

Autumn/Winter School Meals Menu

Our school meal menu is having an Autumn/Winter revamp. This will start on Tuesday 2nd November when we return to school after the October half-term, holidays. Infant children are now eating their lunch in the hall so are able to choose what they would like daily and no longer need to pre-select their menu choices. Junior children are still eating lunch in their classrooms at the moment. Please sit down with your child and choose meal options together. We want their lunch times to be a positive experience but we still have a lot of children changing their mind or saying that they don't like the option that had been chosen for them. Unfortunately, once an option has been chosen it cannot be changed unless a parent contacts the school office to request this.

FISHY FRIDAY'S RESTART DATE

We are excited to announce that Fishy Fridays will return after the October half-term holidays! This gives children on packed lunches the opportunity to have a hot school meal every Friday! Fishy Friday's are free for Infant school children (Reception-Year 2) under the Universal Free School Meals Scheme. For Junior aged children (Year 3-Year 6) the cost is £2.15, which should be paid in advance via ParentPay. The first Fishy Friday will be Friday 5th October.
