Captain Chemistry

We have some reports below from each Year Group about their Captain Chemistry visit. They thoroughly enjoyed the lessons!

YEAR 3

Willow and Poplar classes enjoyed an exciting workshop with Captain Chemistry. We looked at different animal skeletons and enjoyed tasting new and extraordinary fruits and vegetables. Poplar class also made towers modelled from the human skeleton. We had great fun and learned so much about animals including humans!

YEAR 4

In Birch and Elm classes, Captain Chemistry talked to us about the differences and similarities between herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We got to explore a number of skulls and compared the teeth to these of different animals, identifying whether it was a predator or prey by the shape and size of teeth.

We learned about our digestive system from doing an experiment. We learned how the energy from food is absorbed into our body and how food is broken down.

Finally, we used iodine to see which types of food provided us with lots of energy.

YEAR 5

In Pine and Ash classes, we looked at forces with Captain Chemistry. We spent the first part of the session learning about levers and pulleys, which are simple machines that make exerting forces easier. We used hammers and crowbars to pull nails out of wood and even created a lever to lift Captain Chemistry off the floor using planks of wood and bottles of water! Then, we made our own rockets and launched them outside using rocket launchers made from pipes and plastic bottles. They were amazing and zoomed right across the yard! We had a great day! Year 6

In Beech and Oak classes the children are learning about 'Living Things and their Habitats'. The children had great fun exploring how scientists classify and group living creatures using Duplo and then attempted to sort a wide variety of vertebrates. Finally, the pupils had the chance to get their hands dirty, experimenting with woodlice to see what types of habitat they would prefer. The children had lots of fun and were fantastic throughout, keep up the great work! ①
