COVID 19

When should I get my child a COVID-19 test (PCR TEST)? A child who has the following symptoms should get a test:

- A new continuous cough
- A loss of smell or taste
- A high temperature This means your child feel hot to touch on your chest or back you do not need to measure your child's temperature

If a child needs to take a PCR test we must have a copy of the test results emailed to us at delveslaneprimary@durhamlearning.net

Those children who are unable to attend school, as they have tested positive for COVID, will be able to access activities on Tapestry or Google Classroom. If a child is unwell and unable to do so, please inform us. If children are generally unwell or children have a Leave of Absence, this falls outside of our Remote Learning Guidelines and staff will not set additional activities/work for children.

Please remember that you can email your child's class teacher regarding remote learning.
