Reminder School Gates

Staff are able to park in the school car park until **8.20am** every day. The car park gates close at 8.20am. The gates **open again at 8.30am for pedestrian access**.

Healthy Snacks

The following is not an exhaustive list, but is provided to help you come up with ideas for appropriate snacks.

Good choices:

- Fresh fruit
- Dried fruit
- Vegetable sticks (carrot, pepper, etc.)
- **Breadsticks**
- Oaty bars
- Pitta bread
- Crackers
- Plain brioche

To discourage:

- Crisps
- Chocolate bars
- **Biscuits**
- Processed cheese i.e. Dairylea dunkers (these can be high in fat and salt)
- Cheese strings
- Sweets
- Cake
- Doughnuts

Reminder Friends of the School


