Our school is an OPAL school and children will play outside in all weathers. **We strongly advise that children bring spare shoes, trainers, boots or wellies and spare track suit bottoms or trousers to change into, so that they can play on the fields.**

## Parking on School Site

We would like to remind parents and carers that you must not drive into the school car park when dropping off children for breakfast club (between 7.40 and 8.20am). There has been an increasing number of parents who are driving into the main car park before the gates close every morning. We have staff trying to access the car park and also pedestrians walking into school. There is a lot of congestion and some drivers are leaving the site quickly and at speed. This congestion causes safety issues for all of the school community. We are seeking parental support in making a change to this practice by planning to drop off or by parking further away from school for Breakfast Club. Your child may need to walk a bit further from your car to school but this will improve the safety of all pupils at DLPS. If there is a physical need for students or parents to park/drop off on school site, then parents and carers must request consent from Mrs Woods, Headteacher. We will monitor the situation carefully. Thank you for your support with this matter.
