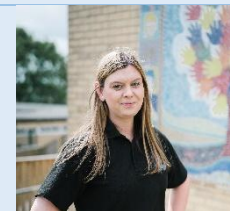




Welcome to Hazel Class!

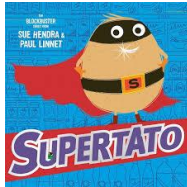
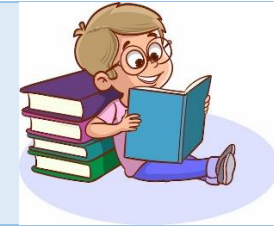
This term, Our PE days will be Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure that you arrive at school prepared with a suitable PE kit which consists of navy-blue shorts or jogging bottoms, a white T-shirt, and a pair of black trainers or sand shoes.

Children are expected to read at home daily. Children will bring home a reading book which matches their phonic ability and must read with an adult a minimum of three times per week. Children's book bags will be sent home every night and must be returned to school each morning.

Reading and
phonics

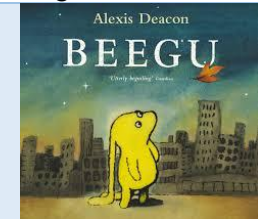
In phonics this term, we will continue to work on our blending and segmenting skills. After revising some of the alternative spellings we learnt in Autumn we will continue to learn the extended code. The extended code teaches us different spellings of different vowel sounds. This will include new books and activities that the children will complete.



This half-term, we will be using the story of 'Supertato' as a focus for developing our writing. We will begin by learning and retelling the story orally and using drama, we will use pictures to help us to sequence the story. We will learn how to write a simple sentence including capital letters, full stops and finger spaces and will have lots of opportunities over the year to practise these skills. We will introduce new vocabulary such as nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs and will learn to give examples of these different things.

Writing

After half-term, we will use the story 'Beegu' as a focus for developing our writing. We will begin by learning and retelling the story orally and using drama, we will use pictures to help us to sequence the story. We will continue to write simple sentences including capital letters, full stops and finger spaces and will have lots of opportunities over the year to practise these skills. We will continue to develop our knowledge of nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs and will begin to use these in our writing.



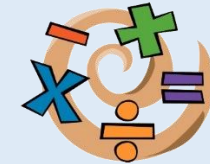
Maths

This term, we will focus on developing our understanding of place value, addition and subtraction, mass and volume and money.

Within place value, we will be looking at numbers up to 50. We will think about how we can count these numbers, represent them in different ways, write them, order them and compare them.

We will then think about adding and subtracting numbers within 20 and focus heavily on our number bonds to 10 and 20, as this will help us to unlock maths in other year groups higher up the school.

Finally, we will think about comparing the mass and volume of different objects and containers and learn to recognise different coins and notes. We will also learn to count coins.



Science



In Science this half term, we will identify and name different materials. We will look at what different objects are made from and classify these depending on this.

We will think about which material will be the best to make an object depending on what it is being used for.

History

In history this term, we will look at the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements.



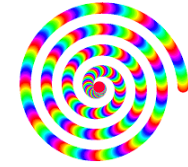
Geography



In geography this term, we will learn about the different types of farms. We will use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key physical features. We will look at simple directions and use positional and directional language.

Art

In this term, our topic is 'Flora and Fauna'. In this topic children will look at art work produced by artists inspired by the Flora and Fauna around them. They will have the opportunity to build on their drawing skills and create their own pieces of art using different materials.



Design and Technology



In DT this term, we will be learning about moving pictures. We will look at some moving pictures and discuss how they move. We will look at the mechanisms used to help pictures move. We will finish the topic by designing and making our own moving picture.

RE

In RE this term, we will be learning about some of the stories Jesus told. We will learn about the meanings of these stories and what Jesus taught us. After this, we will look at the Easter Story and learn about Easter Gardens and what they represent.



PE



In PE this term, we will think about developing our fundamental movement skills including running, jumping, throwing and catching. We will also be looking at balancing and travelling through our 'gymnastics' topic.

PHSE

In PHSE this term, we will think about our dreams and goals. We will think about what goals we can set ourselves and how best to achieve these. After this, we will look at different relationships we have with family and friends and look at how to continue to build these.



Computing



This term in computing, we will explore how to stay safe online and will learn fundamental skills such as logging on and off the chrome books safely.

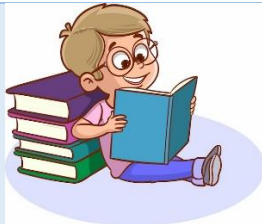
Music

Phonics



In phonics this term, we will continue to learn that letters represent sounds when reading. We will begin to blend words with more complex word structures. We will continue blending sounds together to read words and segmenting sounds in words to help us when writing.

Literacy

In Literacy this term we will explore different stories and begin to write simple words and captions. We will link our new phonics knowledge to our Literacy tasks to help us successfully write new words and ensure that we are able to hear all the sounds in that word when writing. We will have a big focus on our letter formation and will learn how to form our letters correctly.



Maths



In maths this term, we will look closely at the numbers up to 10. We will explore each of these numbers in great detail and will begin to represent them in many different ways. We will learn to count to 10 and continue to subitise objects to 5.
